was arrested by the Aiken Department of Public Safety for 3 motor vehicle offenses and he was subsequently held at the Aiken County Detention Center. That information was relayed to the Greenland Police Department on January 29, 2010. A hold was issued on DUBE. On February 3, 2010, DUBE waived his rights of extradition in court and arrangements are being made to return him to New Hampshire. DUBE is being charged with Robbery (Principal/Accomplice)

ORIGINAL CRIME INFORMATION ALREADY RELEASED

On Sunday, August 30, 2009 at 0129 hours the Greenland Police Department was dispatched to Tuttle Lane, for a report of a Strong Armed Robbery. The victim, 74 year old male was approached in his driveway and his money demanded. There was a struggle and the victim sustained minor injuries. Stolen from the victim were cash and credit cards.
