

INCIDENT: Chainsaw ACCIDENT

On Friday, September 7, 2007 at 1552 hours the Greenland Police Department and Greenland Volunteer Ambulance were dispatched to:

96 Tuttle Lane,

for a report of a chainsaw accident. Upon arrival a 21 year old male was found conscious, but with serious chest injuries. He was apparently struck in the chest with the chainsaw while in a tree cutting limbs. He was transported to the Portsmouth Regional Hospital.
